

Cookie Policy

This Cookie Policy was last updated on 7 January 2022, and applies to citizens and permanent residents of the European Economic Area.

1. Introduction

Our website <https://ronelt.cz> (hereinafter referred to as the "website") uses cookies and other related technologies (for convenience, all such technologies are referred to as "cookies"). We also allow certain third parties to place cookies on our website. Learn more about the use of cookies on our website in the document below.

2. What are cookies?

A cookie is a small, simple file that is sent along with pages of this website and stored by your browser to the hard drive of your computer or another device. The information stored in it may be returned to our servers or those of relevant third parties during a subsequent visit.

3. What are scripts?

A script is a piece of interpreted or compiled code that is used to ensure our website functions properly and remains interactive. This code is executed on our server or on your device.

4. What is a web beacon?

A web beacon (also known as a pixel tag) is a small, invisible piece of text or image on the website that is used to monitor website traffic. For this purpose, various data about you may be collected through the use of web beacons.

5. Cookies

5.1 Technical or functional cookies

Some cookies ensure that certain parts of the website work properly and that your user preferences are remembered. By placing functional cookies, we make it easier for you to visit our website. For example, you will not have to repeatedly enter the same information and, items will remain in your shopping cart until you complete your purchase. These cookies may be placed without your consent.

5.2 Statistical cookies

We use statistical cookies to optimise the website for our users. These cookies help us gain insight into how our website is used. We ask for your permission to store statistical cookies.

5.3 Marketing/Tracking cookies

Marketing/tracking cookies are cookies or any other form of local storage, used to create user profiles for displaying advertisements, or tracking users on this website or on multiple websites for similar marketing purposes.

6. Consent

When you first visit our website, a pop-up will appear with an explanation about cookies. By clicking „Save preferences“, you give your consent to the use of categories of cookies and add-ons described in the pop-up and in this Cookie Policy. You can disable the use of cookies via your browser settings, but please note that our website may no longer function properly.

6.1 Managing consent settings

You have loaded the Cookie Policy without JavaScript support. On AMP, you can use the "Manage consent" button at the bottom of the page.

7. Enabling/disabling and deleting cookies

You can use your internet browser to delete cookies automatically or manually. You can also specify that certain cookies may not be placed. Another option is to change your browser settings so that you receive a notification each time a cookie is being saved. For more information about these options, please refer to your browser's help section. Please note that our website may not function properly if all cookies are disabled. If you delete cookies in your browser, they will be placed again with your consent the next time you visit our website.

8. Your rights regarding personal data

You have the following rights regarding your personal data:

- You have the right to know why your personal data is needed, what happens to it, and how long it will be retained.
- Right of access: You have the right to access the personal data we hold about you.
- Right to rectification: You have the right to supplement, correct, delete or block your personal data at any time.
- Right to withdraw consent: If you have given us consent to process your data, you have the right to withdraw that consent and have your personal data deleted.
- Right to data portability: You have the right to request all your personal data from the data controller and transfer it in full to another controller.
- Right to object: You may object to the processing of your data. We will comply unless there are legitimate grounds for the processing.
